



Research Colloquium for Junior Psychiatrist Investigators

Providing psychiatry residents, fellows & junior faculty within the United States and Canada with a year-long, immersive research training experience that includes opportunities to meet with and receive guidance and encouragement from top researchers in the field. The Colloquium is a unique opportunity for mentorship, receiving information on career development, grantsmanship, work-life balance, and networking. This includes the 2-Day Research Colloquium, 1-Day Colloquium Booster Session, and pre- and post-Colloquium webinars throughout the year.

Colloquium Awardees:

- Will work with key psychiatric leaders such as Charles Nemeroff, David Henderson, Roberto Lewis-Hernandez, Ihsan Salloum, Kerry Ressler, Carolyn Rodriguez, Steven Siegel, Linda Carpenter, Raquel Gur, Wilson Compton, and others.
- Must be able to present a new or ongoing research project or research protocol in a small group session and present a poster on the same study.
- Are required to attend the following events:
 - Pre- and post-Colloquium webinars
 - **Two-day Colloquium during APA Annual Meeting** (May 20-21, 2023) in San Francisco
 - **Early Research Career Breakfast** (May 23, 2023) in San Francisco
 - **One-day Booster Session at ACNP Annual Meeting** (December 2, 2023) in Tampa, FL

Two Research Tracks

Participants are assigned to one of two tracks based on their level of research experience.

Track 1: In the early stage of developing an area of research interest and needs mentorship in doing so

Track 2: Have a clear area of research interest and need mentorship in developing K-award projects or finetuning

Six Research Areas

Participants are grouped into one of six areas of psychiatric research based on their interests and experience.

Alcohol, Pain, and Drug Abuse Research

Health Services and Health Disparities Research

Clinical Psychobiology Research

Molecular, Translational, and Neuroscience Research

Treatment from Psychopharmacology and Psychotherapy to Neural Strategies

Military and Veteran Mental Health (Including PTSD, TBI, Suicide)

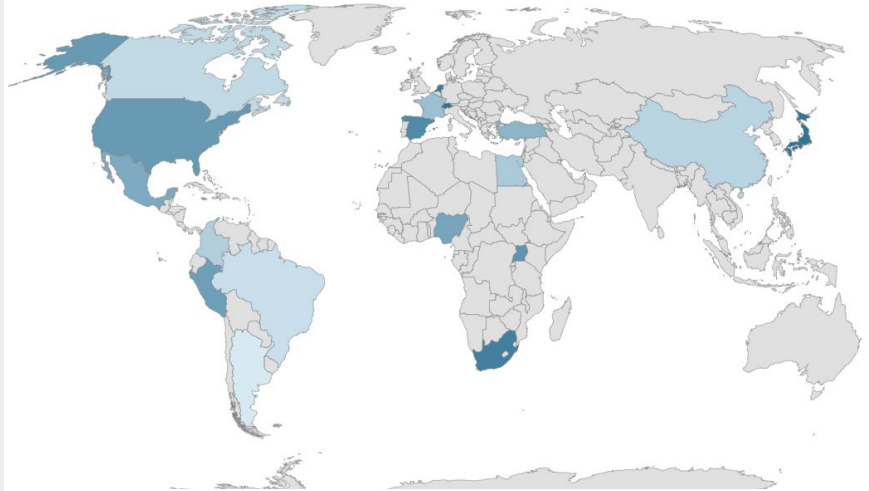

2023 Research Colloquium for Junior Psychiatrist Investigators

Eligibility

- Must be a psychiatrist or psychiatrist in-training
- Must be an APA member before the start of the one-year program or become one upon notification of award
- Must have an interest in developing a research career
- Recipients of major funding equivalent to NIH R01 or R03 awards are not eligible
- Past Colloquium participants assigned to Track 1 are eligible to apply for participation in Track 2 following a one-year gap period



Accepting applications through January 15, 2023

Notification occurs in February 2023

Funding – United States and Canada

Each successful applicant will receive two separate \$1,200 travel stipends to partially cover costs to attend 1) the Colloquium at the APA Annual Meeting and 2) the Colloquium Booster Session at the ACNP Annual Meeting. Eligible costs include travel, accommodation, APA membership fees, and APA & ACNP Annual Meeting registration (reduced fee). **NOTE: Disbursement of the first \$1,200 is dependent on attendance at all Colloquium events at the APA Annual Meeting. Disbursement of the second \$1,200 is dependent on attendance at the ACNP Booster Session.**

Funding – International

Nominating institutions and organizations must provide funding to selected participants for travel, accommodation, APA international membership fees and/or registration.
